INTRODUCTION


CLIMATE :-

Prolong weather conditions of a place/area is known as climate of that area. For example, tropical climate of polar climate or monsoon climate.

Climate of Any Area Include:

- ***** Temperature records during different seasons- winter, summer, etc.
- Precipitation: avg. annual rainfall; cyclones,
- **Humidity etc.**

The location of AUSTRALIA



- The continent is situated completely in southern hemisphere
- The tropic of Capricorn passes through the middle of the continent
- thus; it is situated in the tropical and sub-tropica zones.
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Climate of AUSTRALIA

- Due to its location in southern hemisphare its seasons are totally reverse to that of northern hemisphere
- It has 4 seasons:
- Winter(June-august)
- Spring(Sept –Nov)
- Summer (Dec-Feb)
- Autumn(March may)

CLIMATIC REGIONS OF AUSTRALIA


The continent has the moderating effect of surrounding seas and oceans (neither hot nor cold conditions)

□ It also lacks in high relief features (high mountains which influences the climate of any place ; for example Himalayas in India)

□ Broadly divided into 6 climatic regions:-

CLIMATIC REGIONS

- 1. Tropical monsoon region
- 2. Semi-arid region
- 3. Desert or arid region
- 4. Mediterranean climatic region
- 5. West European climatic region
